You could take photos or draw diagrams as it grows.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Make a game to help you learn your times tables. It could be a board game, a skipping game etc.</p> <p>You could write up the rules or record your self-playing the game</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>PSHE</u></b></p> <p>We are learning about our community in PSHE. Interview someone from your community e.g. road, church, a sports club, brownies/ beavers etc...</p> <p>Find out why the club is important to them. You can choose if and how you record this.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>History</u></b></p> <p>This term we will be learning about the Egyptians. Egyptians loved to keep all their precious belongings in a tomb. Can you label and draw an ancient Egyptian tomb?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>RE</u></b></p>  <p>This term we will be learning about <b>Easter to Pentecost</b>. Pentecost - the coming of the Holy Spirit. <i>The disciples were 'Filled with the Holy Spirit' and that they went out to speak to those who they met. They believed that Jesus who died on the cross and rose to new life was the Son of God. Draw a picture of disciples being filled with the Holy Spirit.</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>PE</u></b></p> <p>In PE we are learning to play tennis. Practise your tennis skills in your local park. Can you serve the ball to a partner and complete a rally up to 10. I would love to know how high you can get with a rally.</p>
