<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Art</u></p> <p>We are learning about creating repeating patterns and how we can apply these designs to fabrics.</p> <p>Pick a picture of a favourite animal (one with lots of colour). Create a square viewfinder, pick a small section of the picture of the animal and create a drawing of the section.</p> <p>Use this square image and repeat it over and over again to create a unique pattern design.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Spanish</u></p> <p>We are learning what equipment we use in the classroom (including what we have and what we do not have in our pencil case).</p> <p>Create a poster with all the different items you could find in a pencil case and label them with the English and Spanish name for them.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Computing</u></p> <p>We are learning about how to create a podcast.</p> <p>Have a listen to some podcasts so you can become familiar with the format – you can find many great free podcasts for children on BBC Sounds (https://www.bbc.co.uk/sounds/category/childrens).</p> <p>Write a review of one of the podcast – <i>Homeschool History is a great one to start with.</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Writing</u></p> <p>We are learning about using direct speech with accurate punctuation to express a character's traits.</p> <p>Write a conversation between two children in the playground using direct speech.</p> <p>Make sure to use the correct punctuation and add description of what is happening in between what they say.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE:</u></p> <p>We are learning about Peter's legacy following Jesus' death, resurrection and ascension to Heaven.</p> <p>Write an explanation text, create a fact file or design a poster explaining who Peter was and what his legacy is.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>History</u></p> <p>We are learning about the Ancient Maya.</p> <p>The Ancient Maya had an artistic culture and created amazing artwork including ceremonial masks. Maya masks depicted powerful animals, important gods and the kings and queens.</p> <p>Design your own Maya mask using the colours gold, red, black green and Maya blue (turquoise).</p>
