Key Knowledge

This half term, Year 6 will focus on scripture from the Gospel of St John, exploring its meaning and significance. By the end of this unit, pupils will hear and reflect on the following key texts:

The Wedding at Cana (Jn 2:1-12)

Healing the Official's Son (Jn 4:46-54)

Healing the Man at Bethesda (Jn 5:1-15)

Feeding the 5000 (Jn 6:1-14)

Walking on Water (Jn 6:16-21)

Healing the Blind Man (Jn 9:1-12)

Raising of Lazarus (Jn 11:1-57)

'I am the Bread of Life' (Jn 6:35) or 'I am the Resurrection and the Life' (Jn 11:25).

Through these passages, pupils will explore key Catholic beliefs and teachings, such as Jesus as the Bread of Life and the Resurrection. They will also consider how Catholics respond to these scriptures in their faith and actions. This will help pupils understand how they are invited to live out these beliefs in their own lives, fostering a deeper connection to their faith and its application in everyday life.
