You could write the story and draw an illustration or you could create a cartoon strip.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Go on Google Earth and find the seven continents. Find out which continent we live in. Do we live in the Northern or Southern hemisphere? Find the Equator. Find out about our climate. Compare two contrasting countries that have different climates. How close are these countries to the Equator?</p>
