- People being unkind (cyberbullying) 💔
- Sharing too much personal information 🏠
- Seeing things that are not for kids 🚫
- Spending too much time online 🕒

How do we stay safe online?



- Keep your identity private!
- Don't tell people your name, address or school
- Block and report anything that upsets you
- Tell adults you trust about what you're doing
- Tell an adult if something worries you

WhatsApp



It feels private – but chats can be *screenshot* and shared 📷

Strangers can join group chats if invited by others 😲

Location and profile pictures can give away personal info 🌐

Tip:

- ✓ Only join chats with people you *really* know
- ✓ Check your privacy settings



Snapchat

- Messages *disappear*... but not really
✗ (people can screenshot)
- "Snap Map" shows your location 🌐
(dangerous if public)
- Pressure to keep "streaks" 🔥 can cause stress
- **Tip:**
 - ✓ Turn off Snap Map (use *Ghost Mode*)
 - ✓ Don't add strangers



- Fun videos – but strangers can comment or message 🗨️
- Dangerous “challenges” can spread 🚨
- Videos can reveal where you live, school uniform, or location 🏠

Tip:

- ✅ Set account to *Private*
- ✅ Think before posting – “Would I show this to my teacher/grandma?”

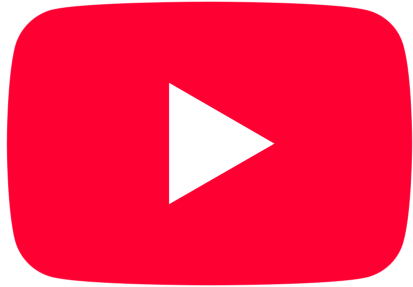


Other Apps (Instagram, YouTube, Gaming Chats)

Comments can be mean 👎

Fake accounts try to befriend kids 😬

Live streams mean strangers can watch in real time 📡



Golden Rules for Staying Safe

- Keep personal information private (name, school, address, phone).
- Only talk to people you actually know in real life.
- Tell an adult if something feels wrong.
- Don't believe everything you see online.
- Think before you post – once it's online, it can stay forever.

- Remember, once it is written, you cannot take it back

- Think about the consequences

What To Do If...



- Someone is unkind → Block & Tell an adult
- You see something upsetting → Close it & Talk to a trusted adult
- You feel pressured → Remember you can say *No*

Don't...

- ✗ Believe everything you see online
- ✗ Trust what strangers say – they could be anyone!
- ✗ Share personal information like your name, age or address
- ✗ Share pictures or videos of yourself
- ✗ Spend any money without checking with an adult
