






Year One Optional Home Learning: Autumn 1

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>We are learning about our senses. Go for a senses walk with your family and talk about what you can see, hear, touch, smell and taste. You might want to draw some of the things you found using each sense.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Computing</u></p> <p>We are learning about online safety. Make a poster about how to stay safe on line. You can draw pictures and write key words.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>DT</u></p> <p>In English we are reading the book 'The Smeds and the Smoos' by Julia Donaldson. Design and make your own rocket.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>We practise counting every day in maths. We're learning to count up to 100. Can you count up to 100? We have learnt that God created the world in 6 days and we are learning what he created on each day including the 7th day when he rested. Choose a day (or all 7) and draw a picture of what he created on that day.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Go on Google Earth. Can you find your house and our school? What else can you find? (e.g. St Ignatius Church, Tesco, Sunbury Cross). You might want to draw a picture of what you've found.</p>
