OPTIONAL HOME LEARNING: The home learning tasks set out in the grid below are OPTIONAL. They are drawn from the topics and areas of study each half term. These tasks are designed to support and extend learning in these areas.

Draw a diagram of your setup and explain how the light travels through your maze.</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Create a piece of artwork depicting what the sky would have looked like during the Blitz. Use the internet to look at other examples of Blitz art. Think about the blends of colours you might see and the different techniques you could use to create this setting.</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Research the life of one of the following important figures from WW2 and produce a leaflet or biography about them:</p> <p>Hugh Dowding Bernard Montgomery Charles de Gaulles Dwight D. Eisenhower</p>
<p><u>Writing</u></p> <p><u>My Day as an Explorer</u></p> <p>Pretend you are exploring a mysterious jungle or desert. Describe your adventures, the animals or plants you encountered, and any treasure or secrets you discovered.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>Create a guide for somebody who has never visited a Catholic church before. Explain the different things they will find there, such as the Altar, the Font and the Tabernacle, and describe the services that take place there.</p>	<p><u>DT</u></p> <p>Design and build a model of a WW2 structure, such as a tank, plane or bomb shelter.</p> <p>Do online research to make your model look as realistic and authentic as possible.</p>
