



GEOGRAPHY

Focus: Antarctica

Key question: Who lives in Antarctica?

Children will:

- describe what lines of latitude and longitude are.
- understand that the Northern and Southern Hemispheres experience seasons at different times.
- define what climate zones are.
- understand Antarctica has a polar climate made up of ice sheets, snow and mountains.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Prophecy and promise

The children will learn about Mass, we have linked the lessons to the theme of Creation, focusing on the 'holy day' and the presentation of gifts. This ensures a focus on the Liturgy of the Word, drawing from childrens' experiences of liturgies and Scripture. Emphasis will be on Scripture and how God speaks to them.

ENGLISH

In English the children will learn about the features of a letter and how to write a letters. They will deconstruct a letter and unpick it. They will analyse the following: • the text's purpose • the text's presentational features • the text's language features • the similarities and differences between similar text types.

They will continue to practice their comprehension, handwriting and spelling skills.

SCIENCE

Focus: Animals: Including Humans

Children will continue to develop an understanding of the need for humans and animals to eat a balance diet of different food types for them to move and grow.

Children will:

- explore the 5 food groups of proteins carbohydrates, fats and sugars, fruits and vegetables, and dairy product.
- compare different diets
- compare the diets of different animals.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

Explain that fruits and vegetables grow in different countries based on their climates.

Design their own tart recipe using seasonal ingredients.

Use the basic rules of food hygiene and safety.

PHSICAL EDUCATION

Focus: Ball Skills

Children will develop their dribbling, tracking, catching, kicking and throwing skills.

SPANISH

Children will learn:

- basic greetings, colour names and numbers.
- Spanish phonics to support their understanding.
- to name and identify the seasons.

MATHEMATICS

Focus: Number

Children will continue to focus on addition, subtraction, multiplication & division.

Children will:

- add and subtract two digits numbers with and without exchanging.
- spotting patterns in addition and subtraction number sentences.
- using arrays to multiply by 3, 4 and 8.
- sharing and grouping to divide by 3, 4 and 8.

PSHE

Focus:

Rights and Respect

Explain that people earn their income through their jobs. - understand that the amount people get paid is due to a range of factors (skill, experience, training, responsibility etc.). - define what is meant by the environment. - evaluate and explain different methods of looking after the school environment.
